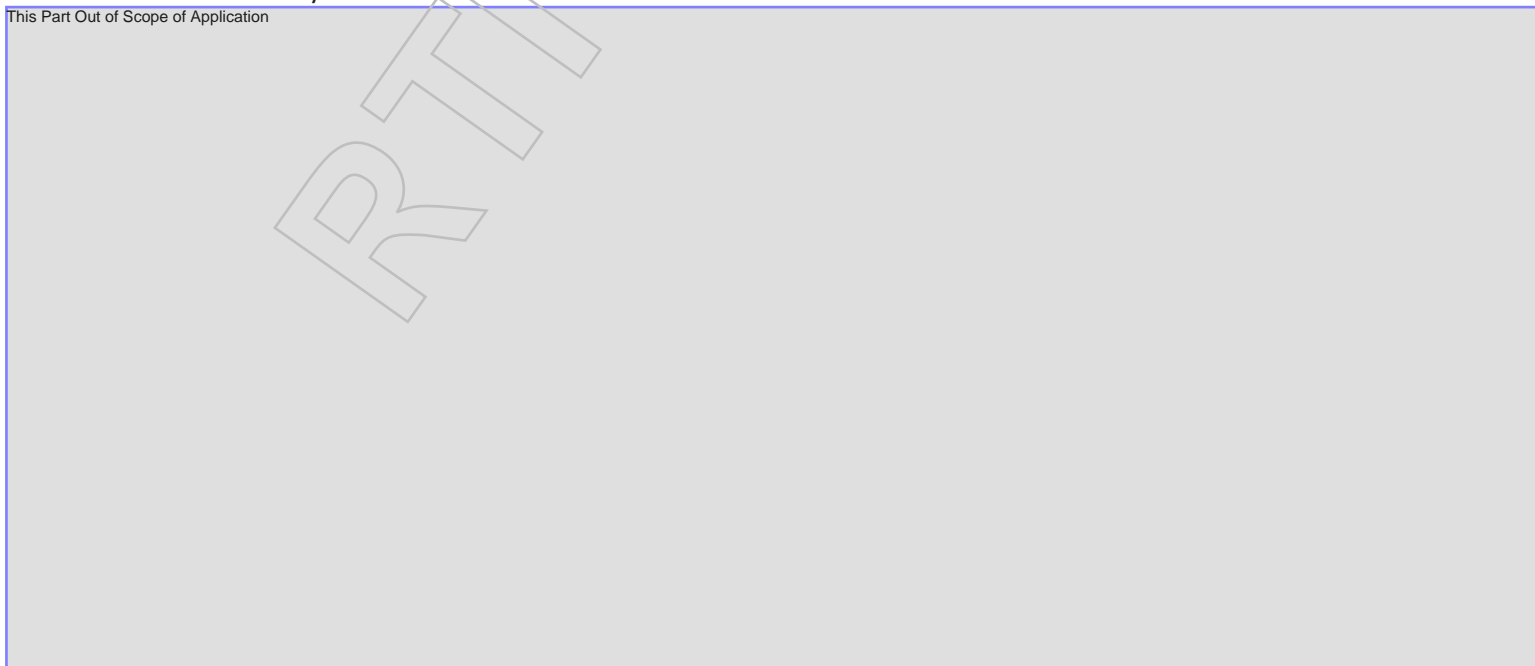
Economic Analysis chapter

- We note employment forecasts from the Department of Transport and Main Roads have been used to underpin demographic data. For consistency across Government, the preferred measures of demographic and employment projections are the Queensland Government population projections (2015 edition) and Regional employment projections, 2010-11 to 2040-41. Further information should be provided by TMR around consistency of their forecasts with these publications and updated information should be used wherever possible.
- The report notes a direct employment figure of 1,256 FTEs supported during construction. Further information should be provided around whether this is a peak annual construction figure or cumulative figure for a certain number of years.
