Proposal type	Details
Minor and machinery in nature	Amends the Superannuation (State Public Sector) Notice 2021 (Notice) to:  (a) update the superannuation arrangements for employees of two employers that are listed in the Notice;  (b) reflect the superannuation arrangements for a newly established employer and declare the employer to be a unit of the State Public Sector as defined under the Superannuation (State Public Sector) Act 1990; and  (c) delete from the Notice the superannuation arrangements for the employees of another employer that is no longer connected to the Queensland Government.  The changes are as requested by the relevant employers and no employees are disadvantaged by them.  The changes are minor and are machinery of government changes as they are routine updates and do not involve substantive regulatory or policy changes. No further impact analysis is required.
