Regulatory proposals for which a Regulatory Impact Analysis is not required	<p>The <i>Superannuation (State Public Sector) Act 1990</i>, and its subordinate legislation, the <i>Superannuation (State Public Sector) Notice 2021</i> (Superannuation Notice) and the <i>Superannuation (State Public Sector) Regulation 2023</i> (Superannuation Regulation) provide for the superannuation entitlements of Queensland's State public sector employees.</p> <p>The regulatory proposal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) amends the Superannuation Notice to remove compulsory membership of Australian Retirement Trust for employees of Gladstone Ports Corporation Limited, update the name of the Games Venue and Legacy Delivery Authority to the Games Independent Infrastructure and Coordination Authority, and make a minor technical amendment to correct and incorrect term; and (b) amends the Superannuation Regulation to prescribe the payment of employer superannuation contributions when a public sector employee is on leave without pay. <p>The regulatory proposal relates to the internal management of the public sector and therefore no further impact analysis is required under <i>The Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy</i>.</p>
