**Specific Request:** Tolling Data registered by Department of Main Roads and Transport (DTMR) as follows:

1. The number of infringements issued;
2. A breakdown of the reasons for infringements;
3. A breakdown of the location where offence occurred;
4. The number of disputed fines;
5. The number of withdrawn fines;
6. The number of unpaid fines;
7. The amount still owing from unpaid fines.

## Response

Items 1, 2 and 3 above have been addressed by DTMR. Items 4-7 were referred to SPER for response.

### 4. The number of disputed fines

Full details of all disputed fines are unable to be provided by SPER as the database does not identify transactions where a debtor has opposed or objected to the infringement notice. The below data under Question 5 identifies matters that were referred to SPER and then recalled or withdrawn. System limitations prevent the identification of the reason for these transactions.

### 5. The number of withdrawn fines

Details of the number of fines recalled or withdrawn by DTMR from 1 January 2013 through to 28 February 2015, are as follows:

Recalled	932
Withdrawn	13,602

### 6. The number of unpaid fines

The total number of unpaid DTMR tolling fines as at 28 February 2015 is 642,412.

### 7. The amount still owing from unpaid fines

The total value of all unpaid DTMR tolling fines as at 28 February 2015 is \$123,286,790.
